Where does your food come from?

Find out how different foods are produced on British farms. Read these jumbled up story sentences and see if you can number them in the correct order.



Strawberry jam

- Flowers are pollinated and fruit ripens
- Factories turn fresh strawberries into jam
- Strawberry plants go into the soil
- Strawberries are picked (or 'harvested') by hand

Wheat flour

- Wheat crops are harvested by machine
- Wheat seeds are planted in the fields
- Crops are sprayed to control weeds and pests
- Wheat ears are milled to make flour



Milk



- Calves are born
- Dairy cows and bulls mate
- Cows are milked twice a day
- Milk is pasteurised and bottled at the dairy

Eggs

- Eggs are packed into egg boxes
- Hens are fed
- Eggs are sorted according to size
- Hens lay eggs



Lamb

- Sheep are sold at market for meat production
- Ewes and rams mate
- Farmers look after their flock of sheep and new lambs
- Lambs are born
