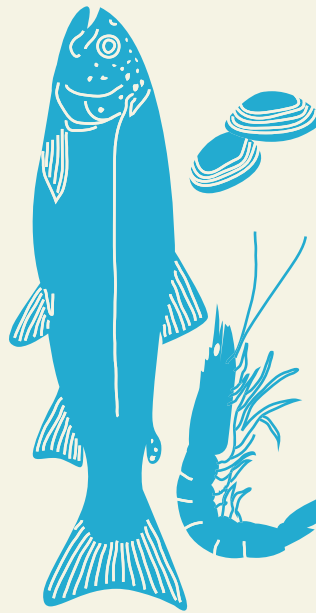

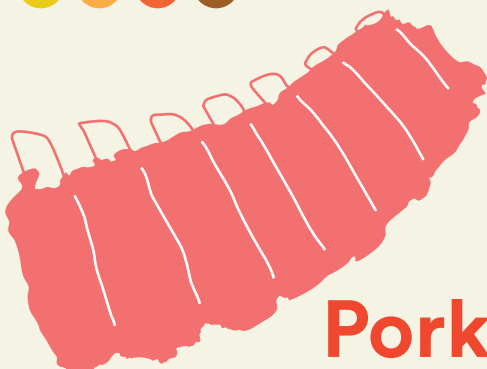

The Red Tractor Beer & Food Pairing Chart

- A** Light Lager – Pale, delicate, lightly sweet
- B** Hoppy Pilsner Lager – Spicy hops, gently bitter
- C** Malty Bitter or Mild – Amber, honeyed, caramel
- D** Hoppy Bitter – Fruity, citrus, floral, bitter
- E** Earthy Bitter – Dry, firm, bitter
- F** Hoppy India Pale Ale – Bold hops, marmalade
- G** Stout or Porter – Earthy, toasty, chocolate
- H** Assertive Stout – Bold, burnt toast, rich coffee
- I** Fruit Beer – Sweet to slightly sour
- J** Old Ale – Ripe plums, demerara, raisins
- K** Barley Wine – Sweet, syrup, honey
